# **RULES AND REGULATIONS FOR CULTURAL & FEST**

## **UTSAV 2K23**

1. There will be no registration fee.
2. No TA/DA will be given to participants.
3. All Participants /teams have to follow all the rules for the respective event Separately
4. All on stage performers will have to report back-stage, half an hour prior to their performance
5. Students/Participants must bring their college ID cards/Library cards on March 16-17 2023.
6. A participant can participate only in one event during the simultaneous timings for events; a participant is not restricted to participation in any number of events as long as the event timing do not clash
7. No vulgar statement of performance is allowed and this will lead to disqualification of team
8. Certificate of participation will be given to all the participants
9. Any damage to college property/any other act of indiscipline shall invite strict disciplinary action.
10. Only one candidate is allowed from an institute to participate. Participants will bring their musical instruments, if required
11. Judges decision will be considered as final

### **General Quiz**

- Only one team per college is allowed, comprising of three participants.
- Preliminary round will be conducted, if necessary.

### **Choreography:**

- Choreography is art of designing sequence of movements in which motion, form, or both are specified. Choreography may also refer to the design itself, which is sometimes expressed by means of dance notation.
- Rules:
  - The theme of the performance should have social relevance.
  - The team may not exceed more than 15 dancers. The contestants may introduce the composition.
  - The total time allowed to each team is 10-15 minutes.
  - The contestants are strictly advised not to disclose the name of their college/Institution to the Jury members/audience while introducing themselves on the stage.
  - Organizing college shall not provide any instruments/accompanists. The contestants have to arrange the musical accompanists/play ready music cassettes/CDs of their own. The play ready music cassettes/CDs and playing electronic instrument should be installed much before the actual performance. No extra time shall be given for this purpose.

- The contestants have to arrange for necessary costumes on their own. The name of the college
- should not be displayed on the dresses in any form.
- The decision of Judges will be final and binding.
- In case participants exceed the time limit ,Judges will be free to disqualify the participant.
- The organizing Committee reserves the right to change the venue, time and rules, if desired.

### **Mimicry**

- Only one participant per college is allowed. Maximum time limit will be 3-5 minutes.
- Mimicry caste or creed.should be of famous personalities and should not attempt to hurt the feelings of any religion.
- Vulgar jokes, obscene gestures or statements are not allowed.

### **Folk Dance**

- Only one team per college is allowed.
- Number of members in a group can vary from 6-10.
- Time duration will be 8-10 minutes.
- Use of props is allowed.
- Participants should bring own CD's, Pen drive to play music.

### **Ad Mad Show**

- Only one team per college is allowed, comprising of two participants.
- Product will be given on the spot.
- 2 minutes will be given for preparation and 3-5 minutes for presentation.

### **Extempore**

- Only one participant per college is allowed.
- Topic will be given on the spot.
- Participants will be given 2 minutes for preparation and 3 minutes, for presentation. Language for the presentation should be English only.

### **Group Dance**

- Group dance is performed by group of people simultaneously, as opposed to individuals dancing alone or individually, and as opposed to couples dancing individually but independently of others dancing at the same time, if any.
- NOTE: It can be performed by only girls or boys or both boys and girls.
- **Rules :**
- Timings: 5 to 10 min.
- Students: 06 to 12.
- One back up CD must be immediately available if needed.
- All CD must be handed over at least 30 minutes prior to the scheduled time at the venue.
- Teams are allowed to use stage props.
- Music system will be provided, teams are expected to bring their own CD's for the sequence.
- All clothes and accessories are to be arranged by the participating team. The organizing committee is responsible only for the infrastructural help.

### **Judging Criteria:**

1. Dressing.
2. Coordination among all participants.

### **Solo Song.**

- Solo Singing is the act of producing musical sounds with the voice.
- Types of Singing:
- Folk Singing , Punjabi , Hindi singing/Western singing
- Rules:
- 1.Timings: 3 to 5 min.
- 2. Students : 1 participant from each college.

- 3. Students should be present during their performance, if one is not there then that student will be disqualified.
- . Participant must carry their own musical instruments if required.

### **Solo Dance**

- Time duration 3-5 minutes.
- Only one candidate is allowed from an institute to participate.
- Use of props is allowed.
- Participants should bring their own CD's, Pen drives to play music.
- **Category :**
- 1. Folk Dancing
- 2. Western Dancing
- 3. Punjabi/Hindi Dancing
- 4. Classical Dancing.

### **Mehandi**

Duration:-  
45 minutes

- Only one team per college is allowed, comprising of one participant and one accompanist
- Maximum time limit will be 45 minutes.
- Design pattern, booklets should not be used. Participants should bring their own material.
- Mehandi should be applied on palm side and up to elbow. Theme of Mehandi - Arabian style.

### **Rangoli**

Only one team per college is allowed, comprising of two participants.

- Maximum time limit will be one hour
- Each team has to bring own material.
- Design pattern/ booklets are not allowed.

### **Nail Art**

Nail art is a creative way to decorate nails.

It is a type of art which can be done on fingernails and toenails. It became commonly known in beauty salons and it is considered as fashion activity.

Throughout time, nail art became a part of fashion and beauty while in history it was a part of aristocracy and determined social status. New textures:

Rules:

- ALL WORK MUST BE DONE ON SITE UNLESS OTHERWISE NOTED.
- No limit for innovation
- Time limit for art will be 30 min.
- No previous work should be done on nails.
- Copying of art will lead to fine and elimination.
- Participants may carry their own material.

### **Poster Making**

- Only one team per college is allowed, comprising of one participant.
- Maximum time limit will be 2 hour.
- Participants has to bring own material like Pastel, Poster, oil, water colors etc.
- Themes of Poster making will be given at the time of registration.

### **Clay Modelling**

Description : A fun event in which participants have to make building and sculptures by the use of clay. Show the creativity of your mind.

Rules:

- A team of maximum two members are allowed.
- Themes or topic will be given at the spot.
- The maximum time limit is 1 hour.
- Model should depict the theme or topic.

- Participant is required to bring their own clay.
- The decision of judges will be final.

### **Collage Making**

- Collage can be prepared in a team of max. 2 students and min. 1 student
- Time limit for collage making: 1.5 Hrs
- Each batch should contain 5 members
- Collage should be theme based.
- Collage making only on full size chart paper (A1 size) is provided by college.
- Reporting time: 15 min prior to scheduled time.
- Participants are required to bring glue, color decorative material.
- Make less use of pen, colors, pencil etc. (almost nil) and make use of other materials more.
- Disqualification- On exceeding time or deviating from the theme.

### **Flower Arrangement**

- Only one team (comprising of two participants) per college is allowed. Only dry flower are to be used.
- Maximum time limit will be 1 hour.
- Flowers should have arranged on a particular theme chosen by the participant.

### **Programming Skills**

- Each team will be given 2 hours
- The participants can technologies like Php, Html, Python, Asp.Net, Java.Script, Sql.

### **Debate**

- Only one participant per college is allowed.
- Topic will be given on the spot.
- Participants will be given 1 minute for preparation and 3 minutes for presentation. Language for the presentation should be English only

### **Fresh flower show**

- Pots should be 3 liters in size (plastic spots are not allowed for the event)
- Flower pots should be well decorated.
- Plants or Flowering pots should have their blooming stage with proper tagging (Name of student, scientific name, class)

**There should be no damage to college property during performance. Decision will be based upon quickness and accuracy.**
