# **RULES AND REGULATIONS FOR CULTURAL FEST**

## **UTSAV 2K26**

1. There will be no registration fee.
2. No TA/DA will be given to participants.
3. All Participants/teams have to follow all the rules for the respective event Separately
4. All on stage performers will have to report back-stage, half an hour prior to their performance
5. Students/Participants must bring their college ID cards/Library cards on February 20<sup>th</sup> & 21<sup>st</sup> 2026.
6. A participant can participate only in one event during the simultaneous timings for events; a participant is not restricted to participation in any number of events as long as the event timing do not clash.
7. No vulgar statement of performance is allowed and this will lead to disqualification of team.
8. Certificate of participation will be given to all the participants
9. Any damage to college property/any other act of indiscipline shall invite strict disciplinary action.
10. Only one candidate is allowed from an institute to participate. Participants will bring their musical instruments, if required.
11. Judge's decision will be considered as final.

### General Quiz

- Only one team per college is allowed, comprising of three participants.
- Preliminary round will be conducted, if necessary.

### Mimicry

- Only one participant per college is allowed. Maximum time limit will be 3-5 minutes.
- Mimicry should be of famous personalities and should not attempt to hurt the feelings of any religion caste or creed.
- Vulgar jokes, obscene gestures or statements are not allowed.

### Extempore

- Only one participant per college is allowed.
- Topic will be given on the spot.
- Participants will be given 2 minutes for preparation and 3 minutes, for presentation. Language for the presentation should be English only.

### Group Dance

- Timings: 5 to 10 min.
- Students: 06 to 12.
- One back up in softcopy/ Pen drive must be immediately available if needed.
- All soft copy must be handed over at least 30 minutes prior to the scheduled time at the venue.
- The dance can be either western style, Hip-hop, Punjabi style or Bollywood Style **but not Folk Dance**.
- Teams are allowed to use props.
- Music system will be provided; teams are expected to bring their own soft copy/ Pen drive for the sequence.
- All clothes and accessories are to be arranged by the participating team.
- No vulgar steps or dance moves will be allowed

### Solo Song.

- Timings: 3 to 5 min.
- Students: 1 participant from each college.
- Participant must carry their own musical instruments if required.

### Solo Dance

- Time duration 3-5 minutes.
- Only one candidate is allowed from an institute to participate.
- Use of props is allowed.
- Participants should bring their own Pen drives to play music.

### Mehandi

- Only one team per college is allowed, comprising of one participant and one accompanist.
- Maximum time limit will be 45 minutes.
- Design pattern, booklets should not be used. Participants should bring their own material.
- Mehendi should be applied on palm side and up to elbow.
- Theme of Mehendi - Arabian style.

## **Rangoli**

- Only one team per college is allowed, comprising of two participants.
- Maximum time limit will be one hour.
- Each team has to bring own material.
- Design pattern /booklets are not allowed.
- Area given for Rangoli will be 3x3.

## **Nail Art**

- All work must be done on site unless otherwise noted.
- No limit for innovation
- Time limit for art will be 30 min.
- No previous work should be done on nails.
- Copying of art will lead to fine and elimination.
- Participants may carry their own material.

## **Poster Making**

- Only one team per college is allowed, comprising of one participant.
- Maximum time limit will be 2 hour.
- Participants has to bring own material like Pastel, Poster, oil, watercolors etc.
- Themes of Poster making will be given at the time of registration.

## **Clay Modeling**

- A team of maximum two members is allowed.
- Themes or topic will be given at the spot.
- The maximum time limit is 1 hour.
- Model should depict the theme or topic.
- Participant is required to bring their own clay.
- The decision of judges will be final.

## **Collage Making**

- Collage can be prepared in a team of max. 2 students.
- Time limit for collage making: 1 Hr. 30 Min.
- Collage should be theme based.
- Collage making only on full size chart paper (A1size) is provided by college.
- Reporting time:15 min prior to scheduled time.
- Participants are required to bring glue, color decorative material.
- Make less use of pen, colors, pencil etc. (almost nil) and make use of other materials more.
- Disqualification-On exceeding time or deviating from the theme.

## **Programming Skills**

- One participant per college is allowed.
- Each team will be given 1 hour.
- The participants can use technologies like Php, Html, Python, Asp.Net, JavaScript, SQL.

## Debate

- Each team will consist of two or three speakers.
- The participant of each team will be given a time limit not exceeding 10 minutes to speak on the subject.
- State the facts, and not just your personal opinion.
- Participants should respect their opponents.
- Do not shout.
- Language can either be Hindi or English.
- Do not interrupt when others are speaking.
- Points will be given based on content, confidence, and arguments.
- Each team will be given 5 points for winning an argument.
- There will be no negative marking.
- The team with the highest points at the end will be declared as the winner.

## Science Exhibition

- Project theme must be in science field and should be innovative.
- Maximum 3 students per project.
- Maximum 6 minutes for presentation.
- Project will be evaluated on the basis of innovation, working model and presentation.
- Any project that involves hazards is not permitted.

## Art Exhibition

- It may include painting, model or sculpture
- No copying is allowed.
- The work must not have been previously exhibited.
- A team may comprise of maximum of two participants.
- Work should not exceed 20" in either direction, including the frame.

## Selfie challenge

- Post ***Five Pictures*** across different locations on your profile
- Have a public profile
- Use the hashtag #goldengroupofinstitutions
- Pictures must be original and filters are not allowed
- By submitting your entry, you are agreeing and confirming that:
  - a. You shall be solely responsible for your entry and the consequences of posting or publishing it.
  - b. The entire copyright in the entry and all content included in it of any nature, including images, is original and belongs to you.
  - c. You have permission from all people appearing in the entry to submit it for these purposes.
  - d. Your entry does not disclose any personal or confidential information belonging to you or anyone else.
  - e. Your entry is not false, a misrepresentation, obscene, offensive, discriminatory or libelous.

## Fashion Show

- One entry per college.
- It is a team event.
- A team can have 10-15 members.
- Time limit for every team would be 15 minutes (Including setup and the performance both).
- Negative marking if participants exceed time limit.
- Should carry their tracks in C.D, pen drive etc.

- Vulgarity is strongly prohibited. Any form of obscenity will lead to debarring the team from the contest.
- Use of cigarettes, alcohol and any unfair means is strongly prohibited.
- Teams will be judged on costumes, theme, walking stance and attitude.
- Decision of the judges will be final and binding.
- Teams have to bring their own props.

### **LAN Gaming**

#### *ROUND 1:*

- Time Limit for 1st round is 15 minutes (According to the laps).
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- Participants must have to complete Laps in his/her best time.
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- Selection will be made on basis of who completed the laps before time or at the best time.

#### *ROUND 2:*

- Time limit for 2<sup>nd</sup> round is 10 minutes (According to the laps).
- For 2<sup>nd</sup> round, Participants must have to complete Laps in their best time
- Selection criteria will be the same as first round.

#### *ROUND 3*

If required Same as Round 2

**\*There should be no damage to college property during performance.**

### **Business Idea**

- Business plans may be submitted by individuals or by teams.
- There must not be more than **3 members in a team**.
- Executive summary containing the expansion of the aspects outlined must be sent through a **mail** or **Hard Copy** before **February 17, 2026**.
- The selected plans will be intimated through the coordinators of the event.
- The participants must mention the title of the irrespective plan. For example 'XYZPLAN'.
- Teams need to bring a **soft copy** in a **pen drive or laptop** while attending the competition.
- The idea presented shouldn't be similar with any existing business.
- Each team or individual will get maximum **15 minutes** to present the idea.
- Candidates must bring their ID card with them.
- Each group must follow proper sequence to present their idea.
- Your Idea should not show any kind of criticism against any organization/ people/ authority.

## **Dumb Charades**

- Team will be of 2 Participants
- One team member will pick a chit.
- The other team member has to guess in accordance with the actions performed by his partner in 2 minutes.
- There will be two rounds.
- The team which will take lesser time in guessing the correct answer will qualify for the next round.
- Cheating will lead to disqualification
- No speaking /lip-sync allowed.

## **Face Painting**

- Team will be of 2 participants
- Each team will be given a time of 60 minutes.
- Only professional makeup and paint products made specifically for the skin including metallic, neon and interference paints.
- Products may be applied wet or dried
- Skin safe adhesives and adhesive removers may be used.
- Feathers can be used.
- Air brush system, stencils, stamps, prosthetic pieces, false eye lashes are not allowed

## **Choreography**

- Time & Structure: Performances typically range from 3 to 10 minutes, with strict limits on, stage setup, (often 2–5 minutes).
- Content & Ethics: Choreography must be appropriate for family viewing; vulgar or suggestive, movements, will lead to, point deductions or disqualification.
- Music & Audio: High-quality, original audio tracks (often, MP4 format) must, be, submitted, in advance.
- Props & Safety: Props are generally allowed, but must not, damage, the, stage, or, cause, safety issues.
- Team Composition: Group, events, often, have, maximum, capacities, (e.g., 10, members), and, may, require, specific, gender, ratios.
- Originality: The, routine, should, be, original, work, and, not, copied, from, popular, media.

## **Rules for Bhangra/ Gidha Competition**

- Each team must consist of 8–12 participants.
- Performance time should be 6–8 minutes.
- Participants can use recorded music or live Dhol.
- Props related to Punjabi culture are allowed but must be safe.
- Teams must bring their own music in pen drive/mobile (backup mandatory).
- Traditional Punjabi costume is compulsory.
